We are fully committed to the European Green Deal - Europe's "Man on the Moon" project, as stated by Commission President Ursula Von der Leyen. We have 12 recommendation to be addressed in the EU's forthcoming strategies:



RESILIENT RECOVERY FROM COVID-19 PANDEMIA

- **01.** Put people, jobs and economic integration at the heart of any decarbonization strategy, for instance, this entails stimulating green innovation and jobs, increasing the application of carbon pricing and reducing cross-border carbon leakage
- O2. Accelerate the implementation of the European Green Deal and through rapid energy system integration;
- **03.** Strengthen collaborative innovation through technology and ecosystem research.



EU OFFSHORE STRATEGY

- **04. Ensure predictability for all actors** by providing strategic planning and coordinated development of onshore and offshore grids;
- **05. Prepare future-proofed regulatory frameworks** with least possible market distortions and discrimination across technologies and countries;
- **06.** Leverage EU policy frameworks and funding to help meet EU targets;
- **07.** Focus on building a world-leading European energy supply chain.



EUROPEAN PLAN FOR HYDROGEN

- **O8. Spur demand for hydrogen** by creating markets through public procurement policies, long term contracts and early investment support;
- O9. Facilitate coordinated development of electricity/gas/ hydrogen infrastructure, to provide for new electrolyzers being built where there is an abundance of renewable generation and where they do not create the need for huge additional investments in the electrical grid;
- Enable effective carbon and electricity price signals to ensure cost-efficient production of clean hydrogen and avoid huge additional investments in the electrical grid;
- 11. Harmonize the European system to document the origin of all hydrogen;
- 12. Encourage and support showcasing of hydrogen pilot projects at scale in order to improve public acceptance.
